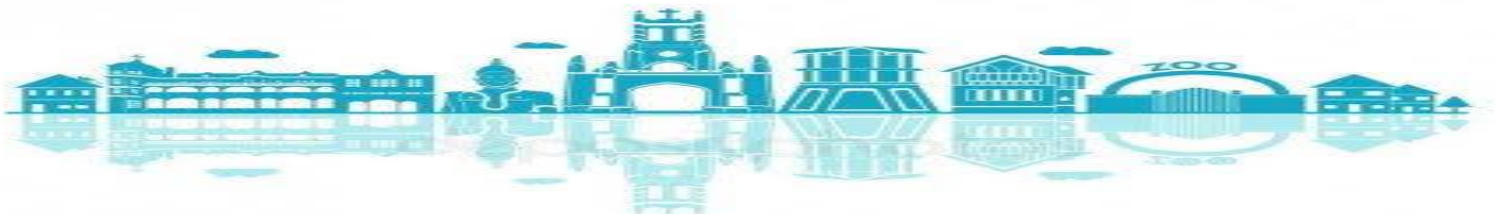

DAY WISE ITINERARY:

DAY 1: ARRIVE DELHI – DRIVE TO SHIMLA (350 KMS 9 HRS.)

After arriving at the Delhi airport/ railway station, our tour representative meets you and helps you with an assisted transfer to Shimla, by road. After reaching Shimla, check-in at the hotel. Spend the evening as per your own liking. Fondly referred to as the “Queen of Hills” Shimla is the capital city of Himachal Pradesh, which boasts of mesmerizing scenery and a laid-back atmosphere. During your leisure time, explore the nearby places on your own such as visiting the Mall, the Ridge and more.

DAY 2: KUFRI LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

Today morning after a filling delicious breakfast visit Kufri. Kufri derives its name from ‘Kufri’ which means lake. It is especially popular among trekkers. The salubrious climate and stunning natural beauty make Kufri a perfect summer getaway. Kufri is the venue for annual winter sports festival held in February. Kufri is also renowned for other adventures activities such as skiing tobogganing (sliding downhill on a sled) etc. Kufri has the oldest skiing slopes in Himachal Pradesh. Kufri is also a haven for nature enthusiasts and wildlife lovers as the Himalayan Nature Park is situated on the outskirts of the town. The Park is home to over 180 varieties of fauna. Thereafter visit the famous mall road of Shimla. Visit the Scandal Point Jhakoo Temple (private vehicles do not have access to Jhakoo temple because of the location. The guests can take a shared taxi available on Mall Road and visit the temple. It’s advisable to visit the temple before it turns dark; hence the guests can first visit the temple and then spend time on the mall road.) After ample of Shopping time return to your hotel for a mouth-watering dinner.

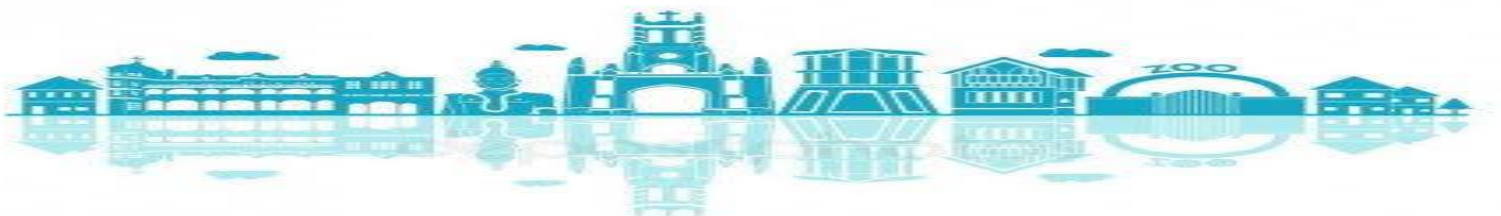
DAY 3: SHIMLA TO MANALI (350 KMS 9 HRS.)

Have your breakfast and begin driving Manali, one of the most popular hill stations of India. Upon arriving, complete the check- in formalities at the hotel. The evening is at leisure. Flocked by honeymooners and family vacationers all around the year, Manali is dotted with a number of attractions. Stay overnight.

DAY 4: MANALI LOCAL SIGHTSEEING & SOLANG VALLEY (20 KMS 1.5 HRS.)

After breakfast get set at to visit Tibetan Monastery- not only a place of worship but also a Tibetan culture centre, the natural springs and sandstone temples at Vashist Village, Later



proceed for Solang Valley where you can enjoy adventure activities like Zorbing, Paragliding, Enjoy the scenic view from top of the mountain drive there by a Cable Car. Afternoon we will be back to Manali town for local sightseeing, Hadimba Devi Temple- dedicated to Hadimba, wife of Bhim-one of the 5 Pandava brother of the Hindu epic Mahabharata and the Manu Temple- an old temple dedicated to sage Manu. Club House In evening we return back to hotel or free time at mall road.

DAY 5: NAGGAR CASTLE

After breakfast today we proceed for Naggar Castle. Formerly, Naggar Castle was known to be the residence the Royal family, until it got occupied by British forces. This resulted in certain modifications in the design and architecture of Naggar castle. Today one would find an additional staircase, fire place and chimneys inside the Castle, which displays a unique amalgam of English as well as Indian architecture. As a whole, Naggar Castle is a unique mansion made of wood and stone, which also houses a historic temple and an art museum. Adding to the charm of the castle is the small temple, which is situated in its courtyard, and is popular with the name Jagti Patt. Over the years of the modern era, the structure of Naggar Castle has undergone renovation, but its primary heritage design is still intact. Thus, making it a must visit place in Manali. Evening return back to Hotel.

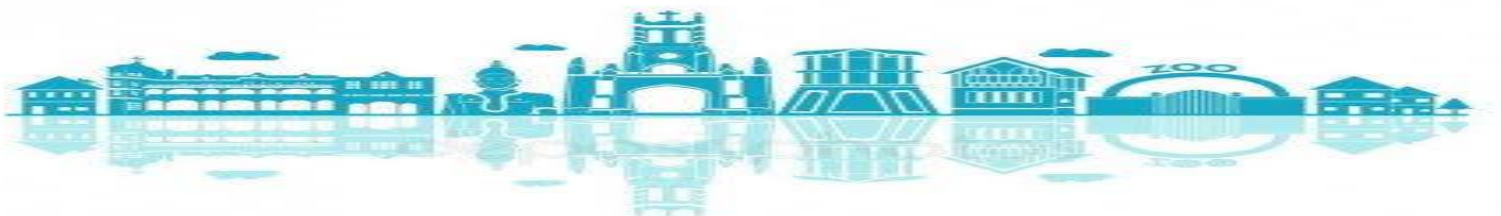
DAY 6: MANALI TO CHANDIGARH (300 KMS 10 HRS.)

After breakfast, complete the check-out formalities at the hotel and then proceed for Chandigarh. Chandigarh - is the first planned modern city of India designed by the French architect Le Corbusier. Chandigarh is a city in India that serves as the capital of two states - Punjab and Haryana. However, the city does not belong to either state. Rather, the city is administered by the federal government and hence classified as a union territory.

DAY 7: CHANDIGARH LOCAL SIGHTSEEING & DROP TO CHANDIGARH / DELHI AIRPORT (250 KMS 6 HRS.)

After breakfast we checkout from hotel and proceed for local sightseeing Rock Garden / Rose Garden / Pinjore Garden and Sukhna Lake & later drop to Chandigarh airport or proceed for Delhi by Road. On arrival you will be transferred to the airport/railway station to board the flight/Train back to home.

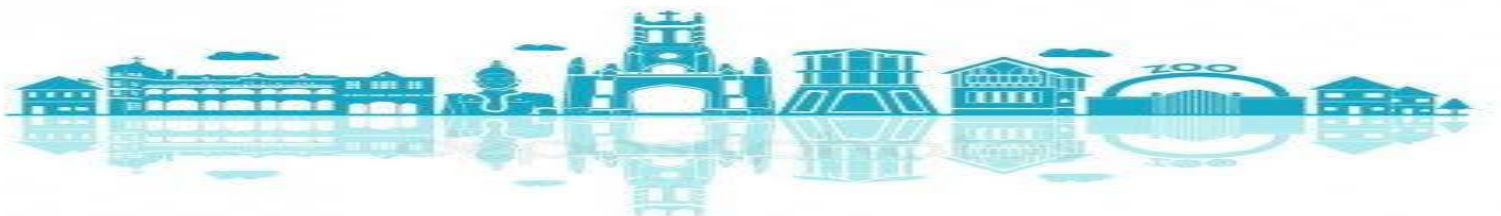
Above are the cancellation rules but we will put our best possible effort to minimize the cancellation charge.

Payment Policy:

- In Case of Air Ticket Issuance, we need Full Payment against Issuance.
- Any Meal / Seat Selection charges need to be paid as per actual airline rate.
- Any confirmation is subject to an advance deposit of 25% of the package cost and has to be paid immediately, after that we can process the booking.
- Balance Payment has to be made in advance and must be paid 30 days prior to your travel date.

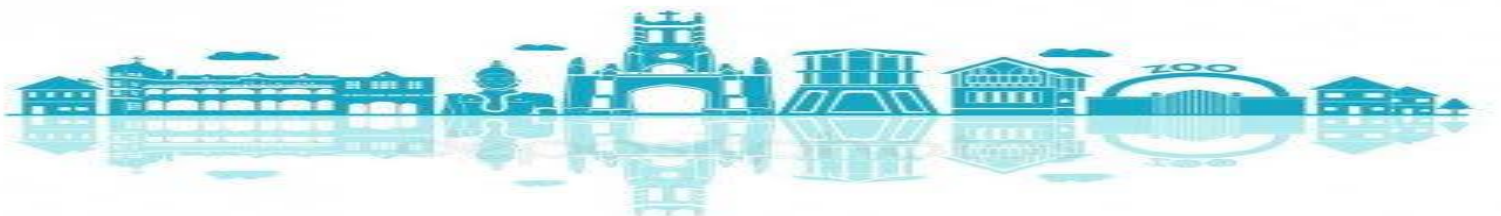

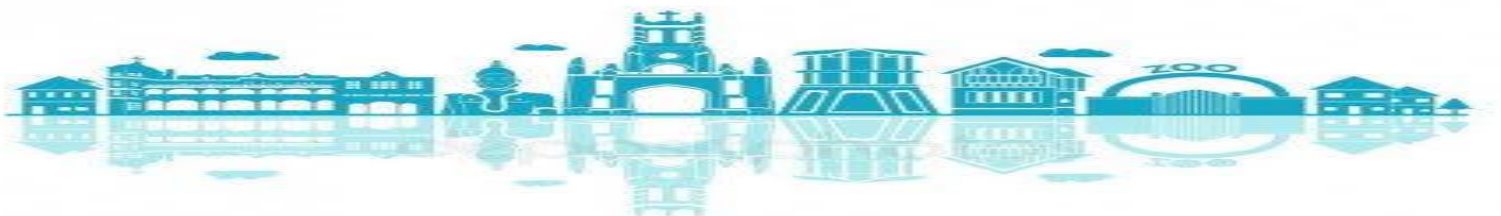
DO'S & DONT'S IN HIMACHAL

Don't s

- Shimla there are rules like you cannot smoke or drink in the city in public place ,if you are caught you will be fined and no vehicles are allowed on the mall road and ridge so you need to walk a lot or find some other way out like there's a lift from bus-stand to the Mall Road or the Hrtc Taxi service running in every 10 minutes from bus-stand to Mall Road at Extra Cost If You Can't Walk A Lot
- Safety precautions: If you have plans to go to Mandi or Manali, do keep in mind not to get too close to rivers as water currents in rivers here are too strong. Also, don't stand on cliffs or park your car in land sliding zones.
- If you are going to Bars & Clubs please do not accept drinks from strangers or do not leave your drink unattended
- Snow dress (coat boot) - if weather is all good and u have your jacket with you. u don't need snow dress. taxi drivers force you to go for it so that they make their commission.
- Food - if taxi owner will ask u to have your food in a particular restaurant then there is setting between restaurant owner and driver.
- Points - don't go according to a taxi owner check online famous visiting spots of Manali and go for them.
- Adventure activities - compare prices of various guides and choose one reasonable.
Do not litter: Himachal Pradesh is one of the most beautiful places on earth. Keeping it clean is moral responsibility of every citizen that lives or travel here. Always keep a separate bag for garbage and trash and put them in garbage bins only. Plastic bags are banned in Himachal Pradesh so don't bring any with yourself. Instead you can get jute bags for carrying your food items. Teach your kids not to litter as well. Help keeping Himachal clean and green.

Do's-

- River rafting - a must do activities when you are in town.
- Old Manali- visit here for best restaurants and music.
- Solang Rope way - check our ropeway. restaurant on top of it is awesome located.
- Day hiking - beside traffic and crowd choose to do day hiking. hire a local guide and walk for a day.
- **Carry your essentials:** Always pack a separate pouch for your essentials such as Chargers, power banks and torches. Moreover, when you are going for a trekking or camping expedition these gadgets can be very helpful.
- **ID proofs:** Always carry your Driving license along with your ID and address proof. Don't ever forget your vehicle papers (if you are travelling in your personal car).
- **Clothing and Footwear:** Pack your clothes depending on the season and the place you are travelling to the mountains. Never forget to pack woollen clothes along with socks and caps if you are visiting in winters. Furthermore, for trekking and camping adventures, carry a good quality rain cheater and a high angle trekking shoe (good grip rubber-soled)
